

ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) EXAM INFORMATION 2023-2024



AP REGISTRATION BEGINS ON OCTOBER 15, 2023!

- ☐ **FIRST WEEK OF SCHOOL**
Students verify they can log into their College Board account.
- ☐ **SECOND WEEK OF SCHOOL**
Students join AP course using their College Board account.
- ☐ **OCTOBER 15 – NOVEMBER 1 (ON-TIME ORDER)**
 - Students join their teacher's AP classroom and register for AP exams.
 - Students pay for AP exam fees in Total Registration (\$98 per exam/\$146 for AP Research and AP Seminar).
- ☐ **NOVEMBER 16 – MARCH 15 (LATE ORDER)**
Students registering for exams after the on-time order window will be assessed a \$40 per exam late fee.*
- ☐ **MAY 6 – 17**
AP exams administered per schedule below. All students who register for an exam and opt not to take it will be charged a \$40 change fee.*
- ☐ **JULY**
AP Exam scores released to students' College Board account.
