## ESL Testing

- Level determined by a reading comprehension test by the State
- If reading test is too high, a speaking/listening test is given.
- Advanced Students will another test to identify reading skills
- Math skills
- Digital skills
- Soft skills to maintain a job
- Cultural information for community living
