- Reviews and helps you study for the certificate, improves math and reading skills, helps with resumes and interview skills.



- Two nights per week:
 - Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday
 - •Begins the week of January 17



ESL Testing

- Level determined by a reading comprehension test by the State...cannot request! DO NOT GUESS on the placement test!
- If reading test is too high, a speaking/listening test is given by appointment.
- Advanced Students will take another test to identify reading skills



ESL Classes

- Classes teach all four skills: reading, listening, writing and speaking
- Math skills
- Digital skills
- Soft skills to keep a job
- Cultural information for community living
- Seats are filled on a first come first served basis and if there is an open seat. As of today, there are openings in every level.



ESL Classes

- You must come to class (no more than 4 absences)
- Practice soft skills like being on time and staying to the end....recommendations!
- Lend textbooks or buy your own
- Can lend some Chromebooks
- Any materials that you borrow must be returned if you need to end class!
