# Registration

## Enrollment - Deadline February 15

*One time process* completed via the D211 Infinite Campus Portal and requires the following documents to be uploaded:

- \*Proof of Residency (gas bill, electric bill, property tax bill or leasing agreement in parent/guardian's name)\*
- Original Birth Certificate

\*Those living with someone else will require an affidavit completed and residency meeting

## Registration

*Annual process* to:

- confirm a student's attendance for the next school year.
- verify all demographic information is accurate
- pay annual instructional fee

Information regarding annual process sent at a later date.

# Physicals and Immunizations

- All 9th grade students must have up-to-date physicals and immunization records on file to attend school on August 11, 2022 (form included in packet)
- Physicals must be completed within 12 months prior to the start of school (August 12, 2021 or later)
- Sports physicals are not accepted for 9th grade physicals.



# Pieces to the Placement Puzzle

- PSAT 8/9 Placement Testing
- Junior High teacher recommendations
  - Recommendations due by 12/15
  - Course & elective reviews completed by 1/10
- Placement visits with junior high teachers 1/11-1/20
- Parents notified of placements end of January
- February 4 - Deadline to change electives

- First assessment in the SAT series
  - PSAT 8/9
  - PSAT 10
  - SAT
- Provides D211 with benchmark data for series & aides in the placement of core courses
- Measures the knowledge and skills that are most essential for college and career readiness and success

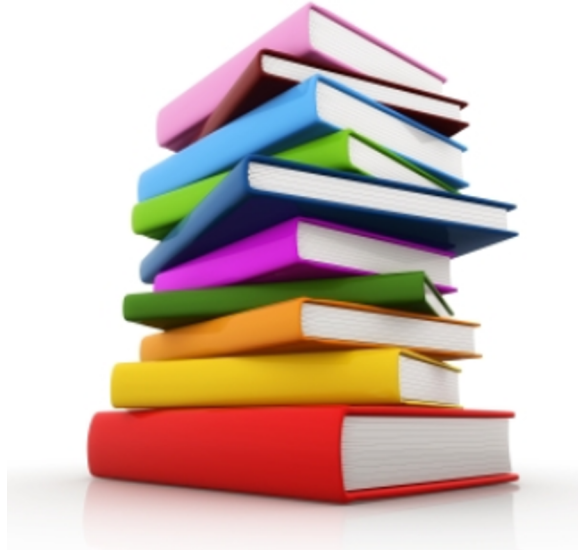

- Physical education for each semester of junior & senior year
- Pass Constitution
- Complete the FAFSA
- Participate in State testing during junior year

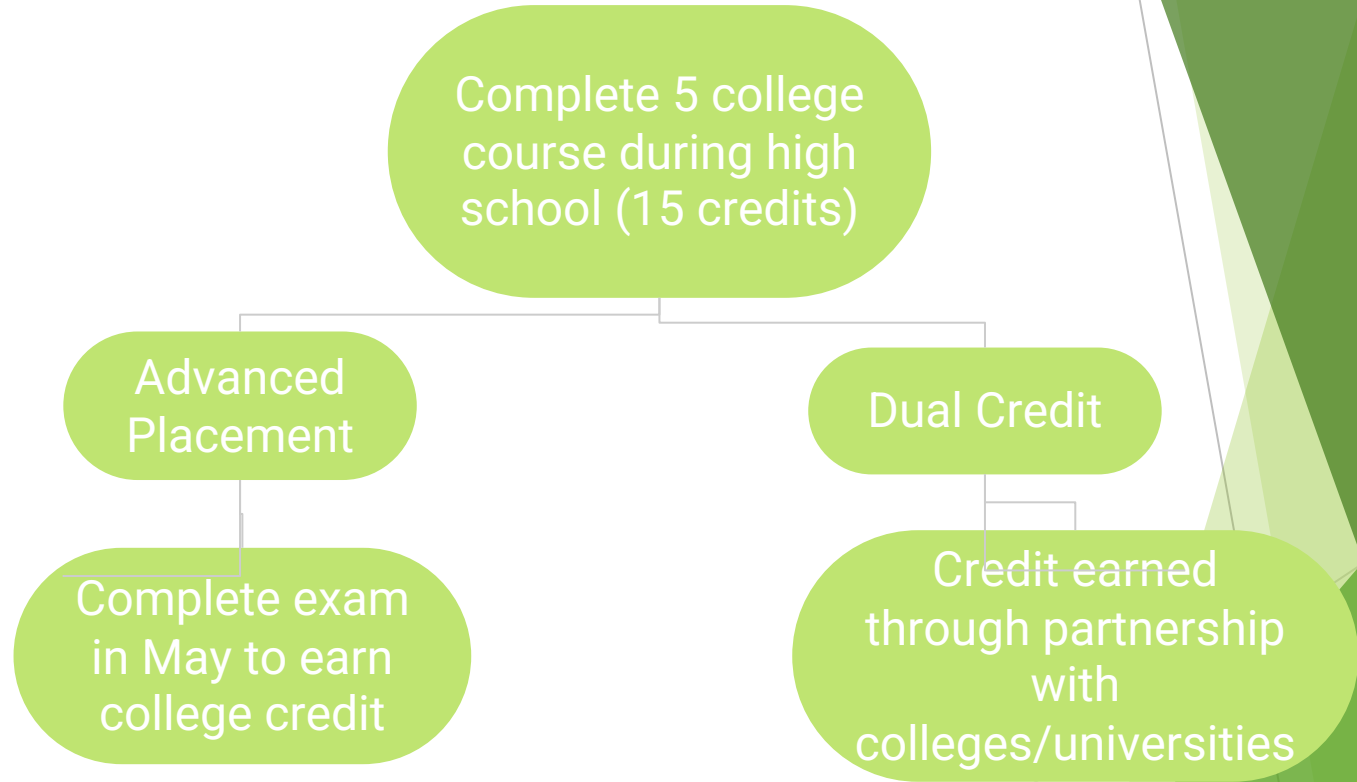

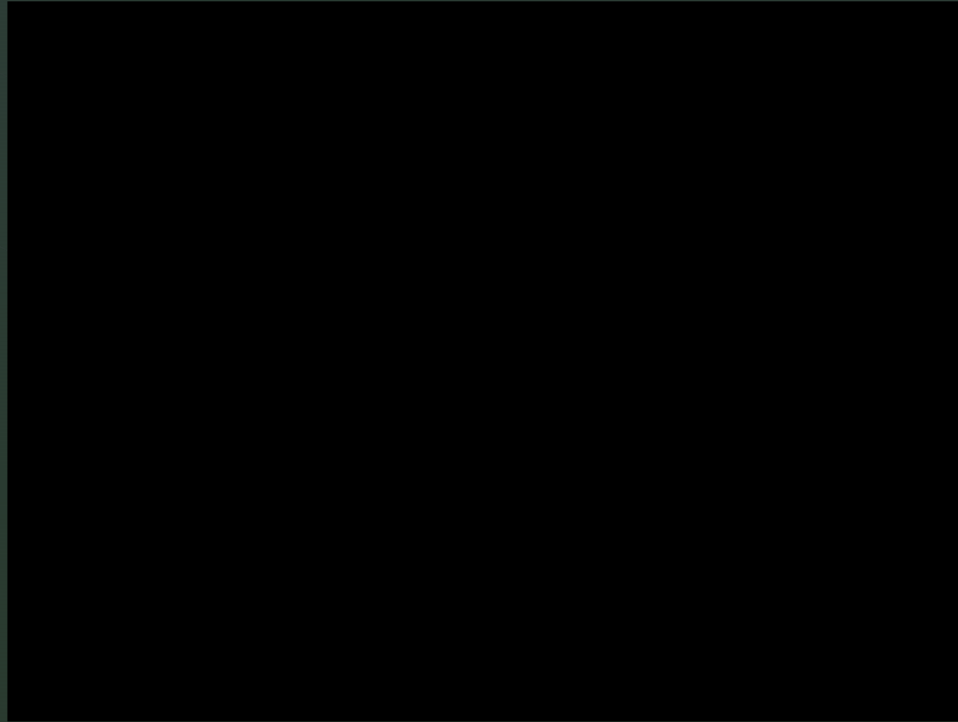

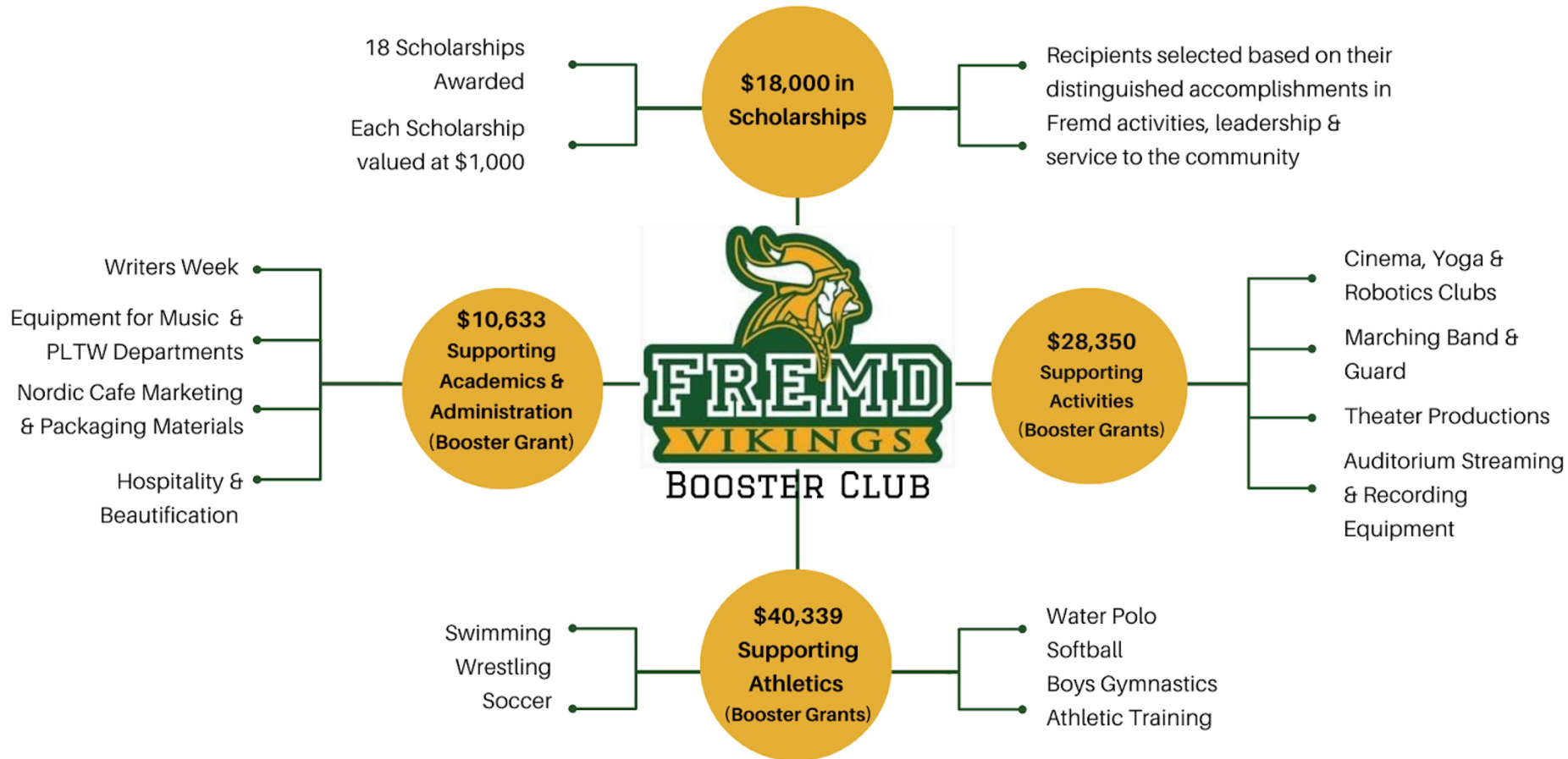
