

The largest book published is 7.48 m² (80 ft² 74 in²), and was achieved by iWRITE Literacy Organization, The Bryan Museum, and Ordinary People Change the World (all USA) in Houston, Texas, USA, on 5 November 2022. Based on the bestselling series by Brad Meltzer and Christopher Eliopoulos, the book titled, "I Am Texas" is a compilation of Texas themed stories and artwork by onethousand students. Organizers plan to tour the book across the state.
