Creative Corner

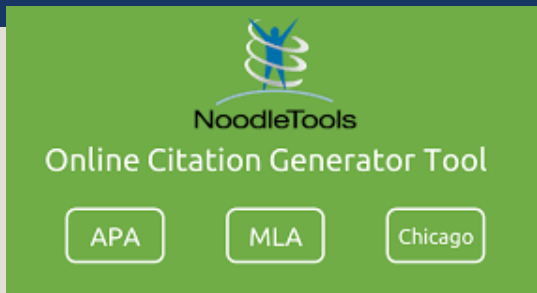

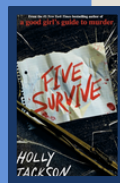
Book Club
