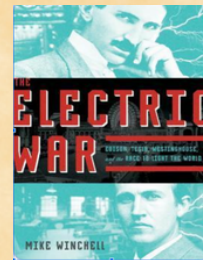
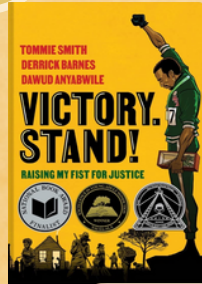
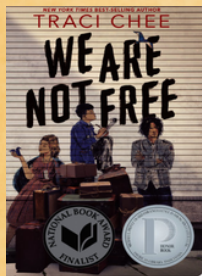

DID YOU KNOW...

A book nearly 90 years overdue returned
to New York library

A copy of Conrad's "Youth and Two Other
Stories" was returned to Larchmont Public
Library last month after it was checked out
in 1933. The book, originally published in
1925, was due to be returned on October
11, 1933.

Officials said the book could have
accumulated a fine of over \$6,400 at the 20-
cents-per-day rate, but fines are capped at
\$5.
