EASY SET UP

- Structure and timing is flexible based on the mutually agreed upon conditions between the company and the student. It can range from 1 week to 2 months in length.

- Only a few requirements: Offer a physical space, an orientation of the business, a supervisor, training, work for the intern to do with specific and realistic expectations, and exposure to various departments within the organization.
