Driver Education

I have read and understand that I must meet the Illinois State mandated requirements for Driver Education. These requirements are as follows:

Phase 1: Classroom (36 periods)- More than 3 absences from classroom must be made up or can result in failure by default. The student will not meet graduation requirements.

Phase 3: Behind the Wheel BTW (15 lessons)- All absences must be made up or can result in failure by default.

A valid permit- Must be in your possession for all drives. Failure to obtain a permit by the **third drive** will cause you to be dropped from the BTW phase. Refund will be given.

I understand that it is my responsibility to make up any missed classrooms and BTW's at my earliest opportunity. A limited number of make-up opportunities are offered during the school year. I am aware that my free time may not match the make-up opportunities and therefore I must talk to my instructor to make arrangements.

FAILURE TO MEET ANY OF THESE STATE REQUIREMENTS WILL RESULT IN FAILURE BY DEFAULT.

YOU MUST PASS BOTH PHASES IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE YOUR LICENSE.

Also, the Illinois Vehicle Code Section 6-301 regarding unlawful use of license or permit states it is a Class C misdemeanor for any person:

- 1. to display, cause, permit to be displayed, or have in his possession any cancelled, revoked, suspended, fictitious, or fraudulently altered license or permit:
- 2. lend his license or permit to any other person or knowingly allow the use of thereof by another;
- 3. to display or represent as his own any license or permit not issued to him;
