




HIGH SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS REVIEW

World Language, Career & Technical Education or Fine Arts	1 year




COLLEGE REQUIREMENTS REVIEW



	4-year school	Highly selective school
English	4 years	4 years
Math	3 years	4 years
Science	3 years	4 year (Biology, Chemistry and Physics)
Social Studies	3 years	3 to 4 years
World Language	2 years (level 2)	2 to 4 years of one language
Career & Technical Education or Fine Arts	2 year – May include courses in Applied Tech, Art, Business Education, Family & Consumer Sciences	1 year recommended






