All teens are invited to come the 1st and 3rd Wednesdays of each month from 6:00-8:00 PM

The Kenneth Young Center is now offering Vaping Intervention Workshops for Schaumburg High School students.

The tobacco companies that make e-cigarettes/vapes are experts in manipulating young people into using these products. Often times youth do not know that these products contain nicotine, which is addictive and harmful to developing brains, lungs, and the circulatory system. Peer pressure is also a contributing factor to use of these products.

Instead of facing suspension/getting an expensive ticket, students who have been caught with vapes on school campus can take part in a 2 session workshop modified from the Healthy Futures program created by Stanford University School of Medicine and the In-depth Program by the American Lung Association.

At the end of the two sessions, students will be able to:

*Describe the health problems associated with vapes

*Develop an individualized plan for setting goals related to their substance use

*Access resources to quit vaping and other substances

The 2 session workshop is held at the Kenneth Young Center offices at 650 E. Algonquin Road, Suite 104, Schaumburg, the 2nd and 4th Wednesdays of each month, 4:30-5:30 PM.

Referred students should register for 2 consecutive sessions starting with the first session, which is always on the 2nd Wednesday of the month.
