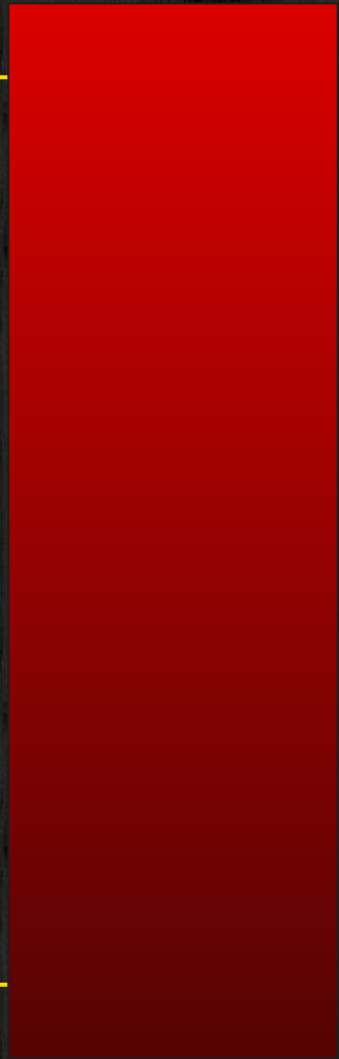

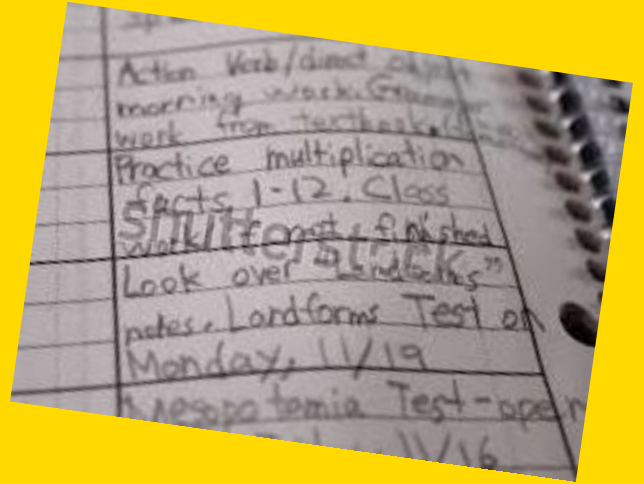

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# Power of 15

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## Advanced Placement Courses (AP)

- ◆ College level coursework
- ◆ Taught at SHS by SHS teachers
- ◆ Only receives an SHS grade
- ◆ Must take the AP Exam in May to determine if receive college credit.

## Dual Credit Courses (600 level)

- ◆ College level coursework
- ◆ Most courses taught at SHS by SHS teachers; some taught through Harper & Triton with college professors.
- ◆ Receive an SHS & college grade = college credit
- ◆ Begins college transcript
