**Vaccines available:**

**DTaP** (Diphtheria/Pertussis/Tetanus); **Hepatitis A & B**; **HIB** (Haemophilus Influenzae); **Quadracel & Kinrix** combination shot (DTaP, IPV); **Meningitis**; **MMR** (Measles/Mumps/Rubella); **Pediarix** combination shot (DTaP, IPV, Hepatitis B); **Pentacel** combination shot (DTaP, IPV, Hib); **Prevnar** (Pneumonia); **Polio**; **Rotavirus**; **Td** (Tetanus/Diphtheria); **Tdap** (Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis); **Varicella** (Chicken Pox), **HPV** (Human Papilloma Virus) and **ProQuad** combination shot (MMR/Varicella).

**TB Skin Tests (Mantoux)** are also available.

**Flu Clinics** are generally offered after October 1st.

# 2019 Message To Parents

Welcome to our **Children's Immunization Clinic** sponsored by the Village of Hoffman Estates and the Illinois Department of Public Health.

Clinic guidelines:

1. This clinic is for **CHILDREN** only, ages 6 weeks to 18 years old. Appointments are necessary and no walk-ins will be accommodated. Adults are not serviced at this clinic, but may call the office to schedule an appointment at 847-781-4850.
2. This clinic is for children who are either underinsured (insurance does not cover immunizations), uninsured (do not have health insurance), or on title 19 of Medicaid (restrictions apply).
3. Every child **must** be accompanied by an adult family member/guardian and sit together until their number is called. Disturbances such as running, climbing, yelling or destruction of property will not be tolerated.
4. Every child **must** have their **up-to-date immunization record**.
5. Every child who receives an immunization (s) is asked to wait at least 10 to 15 minutes before leaving. This assures that your child will not have an adverse reaction to the shot, which may require medical attention.

**Thank you for your cooperation and for maintaining a clean waiting area.**

**To receive VFC vaccine, the child must meet one of the following criteria:**

- **Is enrolled in All Kids with Title 19**
- **Does not have health insurance.**
- **Is American Indian or Alaskan Native.**
- **Is under-insured - health insurance does not pay for immunizations**  
(children with immunization coverage after deductibles or co-payments **DO NOT** qualify)

# 2019 Mensaje Para Los Padres

Bienvenidos a nuestra **Clínica de Inmunizaciones para Niños** patronizado por el Village de Hoffman Estates y el Departamento de Salud Pública de Illinois.

Normas de la clínica:

1. Esta clínica es solo para **NIÑOS**, de 6 semanas a 18 años de edad. Citas son necesarias y no podemos acomodar a nadie sin cita. No atendemos adultos en esta clínica, pero puede llamar a la oficina para hacer una cita al 847-781-4850.
2. Esta clínica es para niños que son infraasegurados (seguro médico no paga por inmunizaciones), sin seguro médico, o título 19 de Medicaid (restricciones aplican).
3. Cada niño **debe** ser acompañado por un familiar adulto y sentarse juntos hasta que se llame su número. Distracciones tal y como correr, gritar, o la destrucción de propiedad no será tolerado.
4. Cada niño **debe** tener su **registro de inmunizaciones al día**.
5. Cada niño que recibe inmunizaciones se le pide esperar al menos 10 a 15 minutos antes de irse. Esto asegura que su niño no tenga una reacción adversa a la vacuna, la cual pueda requerir de atención médica.

**Gracias por su cooperación y por su ayuda en mantener el área de espera limpia.**

**Para recibir la vacuna VFC, el niño debe tener uno de los siguientes criterios:**

- **Es registrado en All Kids con Título 19**
- **No tiene seguro médico.**
- **Es Americano Indígena o Nativo de Alaska.**
- **Es infraasegurado - el seguro médico no paga para inmunizaciones**  
(niños con cobertura de inmunización después de deducibles o co-pagos **NO** califican)
