EVENT INFORMATION:

- Post Prom is optional, but you MUST attend Prom in order to attend Post Prom.
- Buses will leave the Marriott Hoffman Estates at 11:15pm.
- We will return to the Marriott around 4am.
- All students MUST travel to and from the event in the H.E.L.P. provided transportation (buses).
- Shoes MUST be worn at all times. Please bring/wear comfortable shoes for the boat.

IMPORTANT PROCEDURES:

- Any Junior or Senior can purchase tickets.
- Bring your SIGNED permission form and cash-only when purchasing tickets. Permission forms MUST be completed in full for each person attending, whether or not they currently attend HEHS. If the permission slip is not completed and/or you do not have cash, you WILL NOT be able to purchase tickets.
- If you want to be on the same bus as your friends, purchase your tickets early and at the same time.

Post Prom Guidelines

- If you are in a group and would like to have one person from your group purchase the tickets for your group, this will be acceptable. This person **MUST** have all the completed permission slips and cash from everyone in your group ready at the time of ticket sales, or no tickets will be issued. Also, a parent may purchase tickets for their child in the event they cannot be present at the time of ticket sales, with the same restrictions listed above.
- If you wish to sit on the bus with another couple, please be sure to purchase your tickets together. Bus numbers are assigned in the order that Post Prom tickets are sold.
- **Post Prom tickets are Non-Transferable and Non-Refundable.** If you change your mind and are not going to use your ticket, please contact a member of the Post Prom committee. Do not give your ticket to anyone else. This is a safety issue and will be strictly enforced (the ticket is tied to the Emergency form).
- **Any changes from the original permission slip must be cleared through one of the committee members.** For example, if you decide to change your date for the prom, a new permission slip must be filled out before the day of the prom. Please notify us as soon as you know of a change.
- The procedure for check-in will be as follows: Prom will conclude at 11pm. **There will be an announcement instructing you that ALL buses are boarding.** You will go to your assigned bus at that time. **No one will be allowed to go to his or her car.** Please keep in mind that all buses depart from Marriott Hoffman Estates at the same time.
- **Make sure you have your Post Prom ticket and student ID or state ID/driver's license (guest must also have an ID).** It is very important that everyone shows their ID to the chaperone assigned to their bus and they will check your name off the list. Note: on the day of ticket sales, there will be an information sheet for everyone to take. This sheet will have information regarding the drop off dates and times.
- This is a **drug-free, alcohol-free and smoke-free activity.** Please respect these rules.
- **No student or guest may provide his/her own transportation to or from the venue.** Everyone **MUST** ride to and from the Post Prom event on the H.E.L.P. provided buses.

Due to the large number of students involved in this event, it is imperative that the rules be followed so that you can all enjoy a safe and memorable experience. If any students do not comply with the Post Prom rules, the Administration will deal with them accordingly.

**STUDENTS: Don't forget to bring your Post Prom ticket
and student ID or state ID/driver's license to the event!**
