Finding the Right Fit

What to think about when selecting your school?

- Size
- Rigor/Selectivity
- Distance
- Setting/Town
- Private vs Public
- Major
- Social Life/Friends
- School Environment/Religion
- Special Services
- Cost (Do not let it prevent you from applying)
- Visit colleges to identify your preference in a campus
- Meet with college representatives that visit your school



What do colleges want to see?

- Grades/GPA
 - Can submit weighted or unweighted GPA
 - If you are unsure which to submit, talk to your School Counselor!
- Course Rigor
 - Did you challenge yourself?
- Test Scores
 - Order official scores from College Board / ACT
- Essay
- Letter of Rec
- ► Extra Curriculars (1-2 & leadership roles if applicable)
- Student Interests

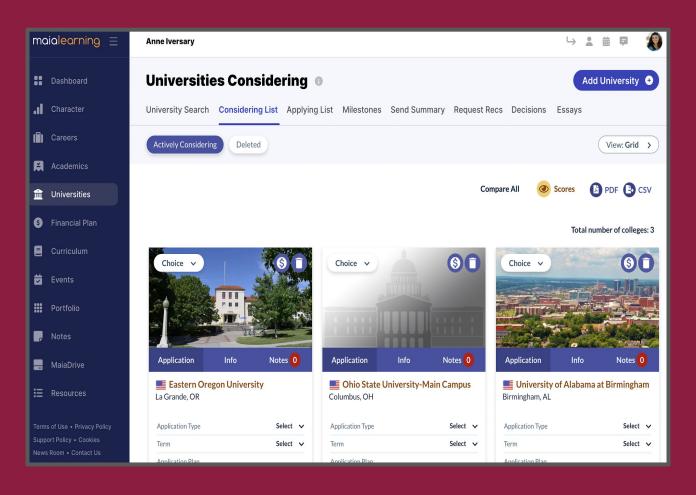

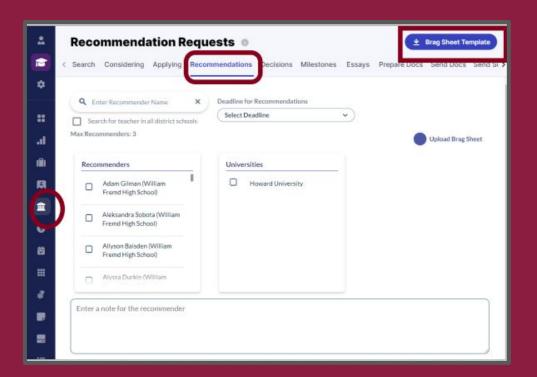
Letter of Recommendations

- Do not request any letters of recommendation until the first day of school!
- You are allowed to request a letter of recommendation from a maximum of 3 recommenders
- Meet with your recommender AT LEAST 4 weeks before the first application due date
- Your Brag Sheet should be completed and uploaded into MaiaLearning under "Universities - Recommendations" to provide an accurate reflection of "your story"
- It is helpful if you provide your letter writers a copy of your personal statement so that they can have a holistic view of your application

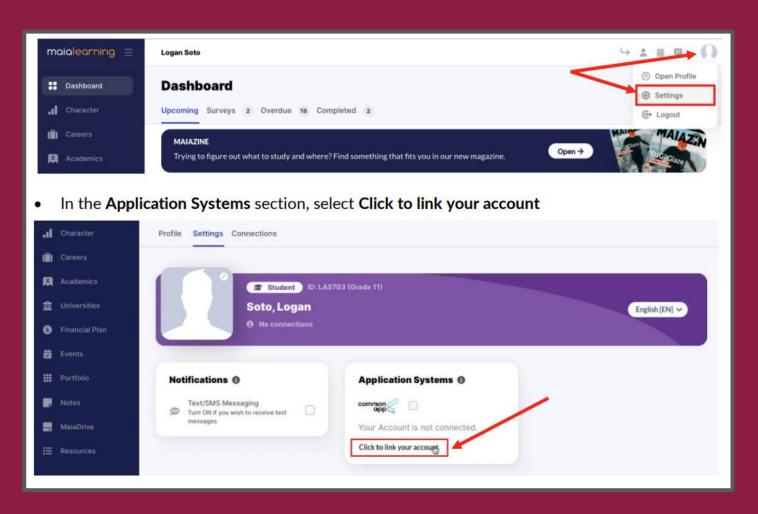

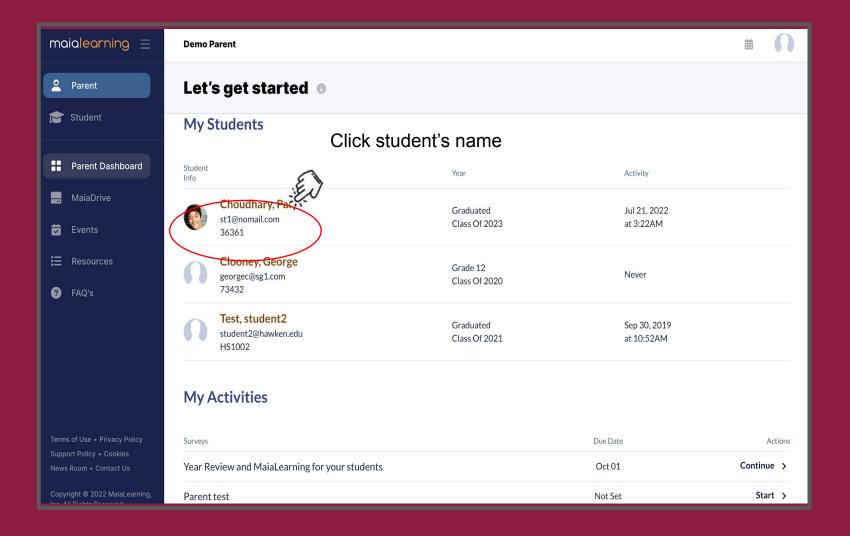

Financial Aid

Merit Aid

Scholarships awarded to students based off applications including grades, test scores, extracurriculars, essays, fit, etc.

Usually automatically given to students

Need based Aid

Based off family's financial situation in 2025 and is determined by family's result of the FAFSA

Can be given, borrowed, or earned

What is the FAFSA?



Free Application for Federal Student Aid

- Graduation requirement for all seniors in the state of Illinois
- Needs to be completed by graduation in order for students to get their diploma
- Should be open by October 1st for families to fill out and we recommend filling it out ASAP!

What is needed for the FAFSA?

- Student and parent's FSA ID that you can create here:
- Student and parent's social security numbers
- 2024 taxes
- Current balance of cash, savings, and checking accounts
- Net worth of investments, businesses, or farms
- Records of child support received (if applicable)

What other options are available for my student or family?

Alternative Application

- For students who do not have a social security number
- Allows them to still be eligible for state aid
- Satisfies graduation requirement



Nonparticipation Form

- Form student fills out if over 18 or student and parent fill out if under
 18 stating that they do not want to fill out the FAFSA at this time
- Can always fill out the FAFSA if family changes their minds
- Satisfies graduation requirement
- Will be available in the fall on the ISAC Website
- Need help with the FAFSA? Your home school will have Financial Aid Nights, FAFSA Workshops, open FAFSA Advising Hours and more this fall!

TESTING Utilize time this summer to take another SAT or ACT exam if you hope to get a higher score! You can apply with either a SAT or ACT score this fall. SAT: Summer Dates - June 7th and August 23rd (register here) ACT: Summer Dates - June 14th and July 12th (register here)
COLLEGE LIST Work on your college list! • 6-12 schools • Mix of safety, match, and reach schools • Need help finding colleges? Use the University search on Maia Learning or College Board's Big Future search tool!
VISIT COLLEGES Visit colleges you might be interested in this summer! To plan formal visits, visit the school's website or reach out to their office of admissions. This can help narrow down your list!
