Classes are online right now using Zoom to be with your class and teacher safely.

Hybrid classes could be offered in January-February if allowed for alternative high school.

ESL classes will remain remote with Zoom.



You will choose a date and time and location to come in and take a test.

- ▶ We offer classes in English as a Second Language (ESL) in 6 levels. (the test will determine your level).
- ▶ We offer a high school credit program. You can earn a D211 high school diploma!
- ▶ We will offer a Bridge to Healthcare class. Come and learn skills needed in the medical field. We will offer a certificate program next fall. This requires a math and reading test. If you are a current ESL student, you will need to make an appointment for both tests.

- ▶ ESL classes are either on Mondays/Wednesdays or Tuesdays/Thursdays from 6:30 to 9:30 pm (normally at Conant High School, Palatine High School and Higgins Education Center).
- ▶ Alternative High School classes meet on various nights Mondays- Thursdays from 6:00 to 10:00 pm (normally at Hoffman Estates High School).
- ▶ Bridge to Healthcare class will meet on Tuesdays/Thursdays from 6:30 to 9:30pm (normally at Hoffman Estates High School).

ESL classes

- ▶ Google Classroom to get your lessons.
- ▶ Burlington English app for free!
- ▶ Fun and engaging projects to practice your English, math and technology skills!
- ▶ We study listening, speaking, reading and writing at each level.
- ▶ All classes are free but we need to pre and post test you during the year.
- ▶ We test in person when we can.

Alternative High School

- ▶ Earn a high school diploma from District 211.
- ▶ We need a copy of your transcript from your high school.
- ▶ We then set up a plan of classes for you to earn the diploma.
- ▶ Classes cost \$12.00 each.

Bridge to Healthcare

- ▶ This class is partly self study in the Burlington English app and Google Chrome classroom.
- ▶ Meet with the teacher once per week.
- ▶ Guest speakers will be invited in Zoom.
- ▶ This is a free class.
- ▶ Reading, math and language skills can be improved.
- ▶ You can take this class if you are in ESL or Alternative High School or interested in having a career in healthcare.
- ▶ Emphasis will be on Pharmacy Tech as we will offer a credential program next semester in this. There will be a support teacher for reading, math and language. There will be a cost for this certificate program.
