

Continuing Education

Gold Club members also may take advantage of High School District 211's Continuing Education Program. Courses are offered in fall and spring sessions.

- Registration begins in January and August
- Continuing Education brochures are mailed to all High School District 211 residents
- A registration form is enclosed with each brochure
- When registering:
 - Indicate your Gold Club Card
 number
 - Indicate the course number
 - Instructional cost is reduced in most cases; however, Gold Club members must pay for books and materials
 - Refund requests must be in writing and postmarked <u>before</u> the class starts

The Gold Club in High School District 211

You are eligible for membership in the *Gold Club* if you are:

- A resident of Township High School District 211 (Palatine and Schaumburg Townships)
- Age 62 and older

Membership guidelines:

- Gold Club members must present their Gold Club Card at High School District 211 events in order to receive the applicable benefit
- Gold Club Cards ARE NOT transferable
- Gold Club Cards ARE NOT honored at IHSA State series games

Benefits of membership:

As a *Gold Club* member, you are eligible for:

- Reduced rates on selected classes in the Continuing Education Program which offers over 200 recreational, educational, and self-enrichment courses on evenings and weekends
- Free admission to all High School District 211 athletic events, except IHSA State series (i.e. playoffs, regional, and sectional games)
- Free admission to all High School District 211 concerts
- Half-price admission for all High School District 211 <u>TICKETED</u> performances (i.e. major theater events)
- These benefits apply only to the bearer of the Gold Card and ONE guest
