
Most Likely While State Imposes 50-Person Restrictions for Groups



#### HYBRID SCHEDULE (Half the Students Physically

Present in School)

50% of students physically attend school for a full week, while 50% of students attend school remotely for a full week. Each student group rotates weekly between remote attendance for school and physical attendance.



#### Same bell schedule as Remote Scenario - please see reverse side.

Example: Palatine Group is in-person for the week, while Pirates Group connects to classroom remotely for the week. These are switched the following week; Palatine Group connects to classroom remotely, while Pirates Group is in-person.
