Entrance Protocols

Admitting people to our buildings efficiently while guarding against health threats



Cleaning Procedures

Increased school-wide cleaning and disinfecting



Movement

Managing the flow of people throughout the school



Meals

Providing nutrition while respecting health and safety protocols



- Daily symptom self-check
- Completed at home before leaving for school
- ♦ If ill, stay home

- ◆ Face masks required
- ♦ Back to front loading
- ♦ Staggered seating
- School buses disinfected after each route
- Face masks required
- Designated and supervised entrances
- Body temperature screening for all entrants
- During the school day, frequent and regular disinfecting of:
 - High-touch surfaces
 - Common areas
 - Classrooms & equipment
- After hours "deep cleaning"

- Staggered passing periods
- Controlled hallways to limit groups and aid in distancing
- Assigned spaces for students each period of the school day

- ♦ In-school needs
 - O Breakfast options
 - Lunch options
- Meal bags available for students during remote learning days
