

Conant Picture Day

We are pleased to offer our students an opportunity to have their 2020-2021 school portrait taken at Conant High School on Saturday, October 24, 2020. All students, freshmen through seniors, are encouraged to take their picture, as these will be used in the 2020-2021 yearbook. For those who are unable to attend on this date, there will be a retake day scheduled later this fall. Please note, if you do not have your picture taken, the yearbook staff will use last year's portrait picture. If one is not available, you may not be included in the 2020-2021 yearbook.

Students who are interested in having their school portrait taken must sign up for a portrait timeslot at this link (**please sign up with the student's District 211 email**):

For the class of 2021, these portraits will be their senior yearbook photo (please dress accordingly); families will be able to select from 6-8 images for the yearbook portrait. (Seniors who have already been photographed by VIP at their Wheeling studio, you do not need to attend Conant's picture day.) **All other grades will have 1 image taken.**

For safety and convenience, our photo days will be paperless. All images will be posted online to view and order through a direct link sent via email within 10 to 15 days of the photo date. Please contact Visual Image Photography (VIP) at www.vipis.com with any questions or for additional information related to purchasing photos.

All students who choose to have their portrait taken at Conant High School on Saturday, October 24, 2020 will need to adhere to the procedures and safety protocols outlined below. Please review these guidelines prior to arriving.

Student Portrait Day Procedures:

- Students must sign up for a time slot in order to have their portrait taken at school on Saturday, October 24, 2020.
- Students will need their picture ID (school ID or license)
- Only students will be permitted in the school building for portraits. Families should plan for students' portrait timeslots to last approximately ten minutes.
- Students must complete the [District 211 Wellness Screener](#) prior to arriving on campus on Saturday, October 24, 2020.
- Students will enter the school at Door 25 (along Plum Grove) and exit the school at Door 1 (Main Entrance).
- Students are not permitted to attend the school portrait day if they receive a Red X on their Wellness Screener. Additionally, all students will be temperature checked upon arriving at the building.
- Please arrive no sooner than 5 minutes prior to your scheduled portrait time slot.

Safety Protocols

- All students entering the building will have their temperature taken. If a student's temperature is above 100.4 degrees, they will not be permitted to enter the building.
- Students should not attend the school portrait day if they receive a Red X on the Wellness Screener.
- Students must adhere to social distancing guidelines and must wear a mask while in the building. Students may only remove their mask for their portrait.
