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Title I in D211

- Title I of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act provides financial assistance to state and local educational agencies to meet the needs of at-risk children.
- Title I funds are federal monies that are received by our state. The State Educational Agencies forward these monies to school districts who qualify.
- Hoffman Estates & Palatine High School qualifies as a school- wide Title I program, meaning that all students at these schools can benefit from these services.

Goal of Title I

The main goal of Title I is to provide instructional services and activities which support students in meeting the state's challenging performance standards. The Title I program strives to increase academic achievement by providing direct instructional support to students and effective professional development for teachers. It is also the goal of the Title I program to promote parent education and involvement.



Title I Social Workers

The Title I Social Workers provide support for students and families who need assistance. The Title I Social Workers see students on an individual or group basis to deal with any social-emotional concerns. The goal for students is to learn positive coping skills that will help students manage their daily lives, which will empower them to become better students. The Title I Social Workers also connect families to community resources as needed and respond to family and student emergencies.

The Title I social workers implement student and family engagement events throughout the school year to assist families.
