Before You Register

- All students must be enrolled **BEFORE** school registration can be completed.
- **SCHOOL ENROLLMENT** is a one-time process and is fulfilled the first year a student attends Palatine High School. All **FRESHMEN** and **TRANSFER STUDENTS** must provide the following documents to complete enrollment:
 - original birth certificate
 - current physical examination form
 - current proof of residency
 - record of up-to-date immunizations
- **SENIORS: All students entering 12th grade** must have proof of an up-to-date meningococcal vaccination on file in order to attend the first day of school.

How to Register

(ONLINE)

Beginning **June 1**, log on to **Infinite Campus** using your parent account, select **More** on the left-side menu, then click **2023-2024 registration**.

(IN-PERSON)

You must use in-person registration if one of the following apply:

- Do not have Internet access.
- Have a new home address.
- Need to update your child's immunization records.
