ATHLETICS

High School District 211 has an outstanding history and tradition of interscholastic athletics throughout the state of Illinois. District athletic teams have realized successful experiences at all levels of competition, and coaching staffs have helped develop some of the state's finest student-athletes. All District 211 schools are members of the Illinois High School Association and compete in the Mid-Suburban League.

Each District 211 school offers a comprehensive sports program in accordance with the highest tradition of athletic competition and in proper perspective to the overall educational program of the District.

The following is a list of sports that are offered each season. Students may participate in no more than one sport each season. Most fall sports begin in mid-August and run through October. Winter sports begin the first week in November and continue through February. Except for indoor track, spring sports start around the beginning of March and continue through May.
