Dear Viking Family:

In preparation for the end of the year, this letter contains information about several activities occurring over the next two weeks.

Virtual Honors Convocation

Fremd High School will host its Virtual Honors Convocation on Thursday, May 14 at 7:00 p.m., which can be accessed on the Fremd High School website or [this link](#).

Virtual Graduation Ceremony

Fremd High School's Virtual Graduation Ceremony will be held on Tuesday, May 19 at 7:30 p.m. The ceremony can be accessed through multiple means, including the Village of Palatine and the Village of Hoffman Estates public access television channels (please check with your local cable provider for channel information), the Fremd High School and District 211 websites, and this direct [link](#) to the broadcast.

End-of-Year Drop-Off, Pick-Up

During the last week of school (May 18-21), students will have an opportunity to turn in any school materials still in their possession, such as textbooks, library books, sports uniforms, and other classroom materials. Additionally, students will be able to retrieve their personal items left in gym or hallway lockers.

To drop off school materials, please go to Entrance 6 in the auditorium parking lot. Please place all school items to be returned in a plastic bag with your name and ID number written on a piece of paper inside the bag. Senior iPads and chargers should not be placed in a bag, but turned in along with your bag of other items. To pick up your personal effects, please go to Entrance 1. All gym locker contents have been cleaned out of lockers and bagged up. All hallway lockers remain untouched and may stay in your locker until school resumes in the fall. Students will have limited access to the building.

In order to observe social distancing and safety guidelines, students will need to sign up for a time slot for drop-off/pick-up to limit the number of people at the school during a given time.
