



Dear Parents/Guardians,

A critical part of your student's transition to William Fremd High School is requesting elective courses. Elective courses allow your student to learn about specific areas of interest, laying the foundation for their future educational and career pursuits.

You will indicate your student's elective course requests using an online interface accessed through the [District 211 Infinite Campus Portal](#). Within the week, you will receive a letter via US postal mail with login information for your District 211 Infinite Campus Portal Account. Infinite Campus Portal accounts connected to other school districts will **not** connect you to a District 211 school.

### **Submitting Elective Course Requests**

The course request window opens through Infinite Campus on Monday, November 27, 2023. Once in the Infinite Campus portal, click "**MORE**" on the left side of the screen and select the link titled **D211 Incoming Freshman Electives**. You will indicate two electives, plus an alternate request. **The deadline to indicate elective course requests is Friday, December 15, 2023.**

The notice will also confirm the elective courses included as part of your student's freshman year course schedule.
