Dear Parents of Seniors:

As we look towards the end of your senior's time at Hoffman Estates High School, we wanted you to be aware of some key senior events and dates.

Graduation

Graduation is scheduled at the NOW Arena in Hoffman Estates for all District 211 schools. Because of current mitigation protocols and capacity limitations, each school is scheduled to have two identical outdoor ceremonies conducted in a drive-in format. Each family will arrive via automobile in the NOW Arena parking lot and be able to view the graduation ceremony from the safety of their car on video boards with a radio simulcast, much like a drive-in theater. Each student will have the opportunity to leave their car, have their name read, walk across the stage, and receive their diploma during the graduation ceremony. Our graduation ceremonies will take place on Sunday, May 23 at 5:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.

As you know, the State of Illinois may change the mitigation guidelines between now and the graduation date. Should these guidelines change, District 211 and the NOW Arena will adjust the graduation ceremony based upon the current guidelines. Specific graduation details will be included in a separate communication closer to the date of the ceremony.

Senior Prom

Hoffman Estates High School's Senior Prom will be held on Friday, May 21 at the Westin Chicago Northwest in Itasca. We have worked with the Westin to ensure a safe environment for our students based upon current State of Illinois mitigation guidelines. Please note that current guidelines do not allow for dancing and the Prom will consist of a formal dinner and entertainment for a senior and one guest.

Senior Parade

On Thursday, May 20, Hoffman Estates High School will hold its Senior Parade. The parade will take place at the school.

We will communicate additional details regarding graduation attendance, ticketing, and cap and gown distribution, as well as Prom ticket sales and the logistics for our Senior Parade along with other potential senior events over the next few weeks.
