SUMMER SCHOOL FOOD SERVICE

During summer school, the food service department will be offering a complimentary breakfast in the cafeteria to all students before the start of the school day. A complete lunch and a la carte items will also be available in the cafeteria at regular rates.

In addition to cash payments, prepayment accounts will be accessible to in-district students. Deposits can be applied to a student's prepayment account by check or cash in the cafeteria. The online credit card payment system will not be available during summer school, but will resume prior to the start of the school year. Account balances from the school year will transfer with students to their summer school building.

APRIL 15-26, 2019 ILLINOIS SCIENCE ASSESSMENT (ISA)

The Illinois Science Assessment (ISA) is a state required science assessment administered to students enrolled in Biology I (S131, S137, and S138). The assessment is aligned to the Illinois Learning Standards for Science incorporating the Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS). Visit <https://www.isbe.net/assessment> for more information. Students enrolled in Biology I will complete the Illinois Science Assessment within a single period during their regularly scheduled Biology class between the dates of April 15 – 26, 2019.

2019 SUMMER SCHOOL INFORMATION

Summer school for District 211 students will be held at all 211 schools. First semester will begin on **Tuesday, June 4** and ends on **Tuesday, June 25**. Second semester will begin on **Wednesday, June 26**, and end on **Thursday, July 18**. There will be no classes held on Fridays.

Tuition for credit classes is \$140 per semester and tuition for non-credit **athletic/activity** camps is \$75 per semester. The driver education course fee is \$400.00 (\$70 classroom only).

Summer school is a concentrated program and special rules regarding absences apply. Students who are absent the first two days of a semester or accumulate three days of absence will lose course credit and fees. Two tardies count as one day of absence. Summer school students should not schedule vacations during the summer school sessions.

With the exception of the absence rules listed above, regular school year rules are in effect during summer school. Misconduct including tobacco use, truancy, excessive tardiness, substance abuse, and gross misconduct will result in course dismissal, forfeiture of credit with no refund, and possible disciplinary action. **Summer school students are required to wear and properly display a current school I.D. card. The I.D. card must be worn around the neck and visible at all times during the summer school day. Incoming freshman students will receive a summer school I.D. within the first few days of the start of each semester. Students enrolled in athletic or activity camps must wear their I.D. when entering the school building.**

District 211 school buses will run for morning credit classes only. District transportation is not provided for afternoon classes. The fee is \$35 for one semester, \$70 for both semesters. Because of irregular schedules, students in driver education classes may not be able to benefit from bus service.
