

Immunization Requirement for Class of 2020

Dear Parents:

The Illinois School Code requires that all students entering 12th grade show proof of receiving two Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccines (**MCV4**) before the start of their senior year. Meningococcal disease describes infections caused by the bacterium *Neisseria meningitidis*, also called meningococcus. Best known as the cause of meningitis, this disease carries a high mortality rate if untreated, but is vaccine preventable.

High School District 211 has a first day exclusion policy. Students whose vaccinations are not compliant will be unable to start school on the first day of classes on August 12, 2019. **In order for you to complete school registration for the 2019-2020 school year, proof of your child receiving the required meningococcal vaccine (MCV4) must be on file in the school nurse's office.**
