Percentage of students who graduate within 4 years



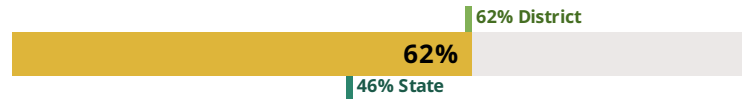
Post-Secondary Enrollment

Percentage of students who enroll at colleges and universities



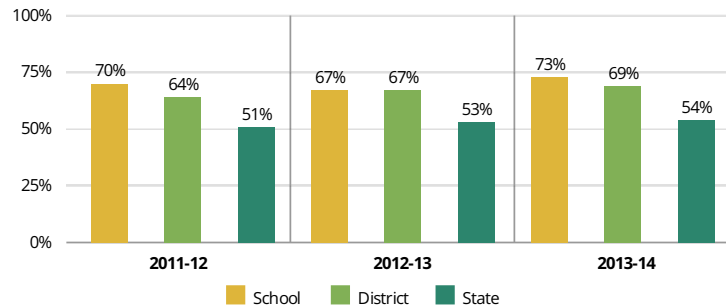
Ready for College Coursework

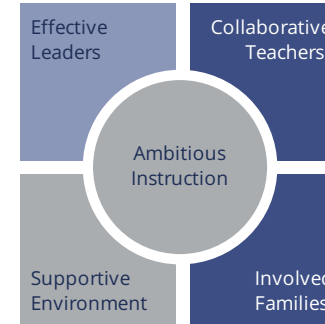

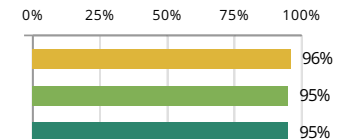

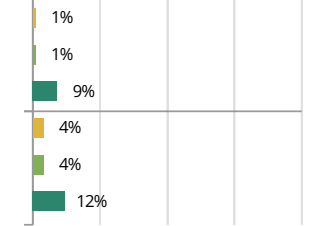
Attendance Rate

Academic Courses

School Personnel Resources

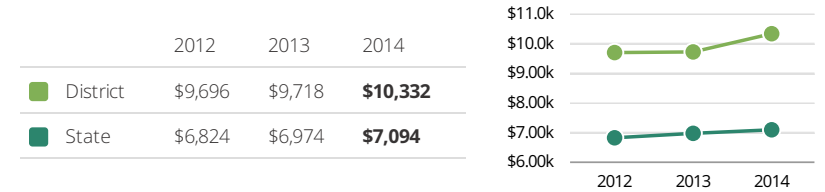
While all CHS teachers are highly qualified, having at least a bachelor's degree in their content area and 88% have an advanced degree, 27 CHS teachers have National Board Certification. CHS also has a full-time certified nurse, 2 psychologists, 2 social workers, 9 counselors, and 1 speech/language/pathologist.

Facilities

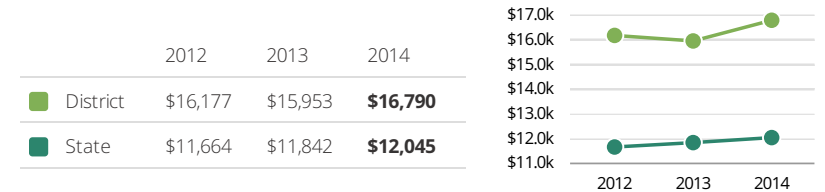
Each District 211 high school is located on a 40-60 acre site, and able to accommodate 2,000-3,000 students. Each is equipped with an artificial turf stadium, running track, baseball and softball fields, swimming pool, multiple gymnasiums, tennis courts, an auditorium, and music practice rooms, plus computer, reading, science, and vocational labs.

District Finance

Instructional Spending per Pupil includes only the activities directly dealing with the teaching of students or the interaction between teachers and students.



Operational Spending per Pupil includes all costs for overall operations in this school's district, including Instructional Spending, but excluding summer school, adult education, capital expenditures, and long-term debt payments.



Educator Measures

In the last six years, **1 principal** have led this school. In the last three years, an average of **94% of teachers** return to this school from one year to the next.
