

REGISTRATION INFORMATION 2017-2018

Welcome to the 2017-2018 school year. The first day of classes will be **Monday, August 14, 2017**.

Township High School District 211 uses an online registration and fee payment system. You may complete your registration at home or at any location where you have internet access. In mid-June, you will receive an invoice that will assist you with registration. Online registration will begin on Saturday, July 1, 2017. You will be able to complete online registration by logging into your ***Infinite Campus Parent Portal***; this link is available on the Hoffman Estates High School website. Online payments will be accepted using a credit or debit card (**MasterCard, Discover, or Visa**) through Sunday, August 6, 2017. If you do not have access to a computer or if you prefer to pay using cash, check, or money order, walk-in registration will be accepted beginning on Monday, July 24 through Thursday, July 27 from 7:30 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.; Friday, July 28 from 7:30 a.m. until 12:00 p.m.; and Saturday, July 29 from 10:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. We will also have evening walk-in registration hours on Thursday, July 27 from 5:30 - 8:00 p.m.

To verify the accuracy of current student information, please review and update the Enrollment Information enclosed. You may submit changes to the form through your Infinite Campus Parent Portal. If returning the form by mail, the form must be signed. If any changes in guardianship have occurred, supporting documentation will be required. Documents should be submitted to the Student Services Department; if you have any questions, please contact the Student Services Department at (847) 755-5630.

The registration fee for the 2017-2018 school year is \$170 per student. Additional fees, including yearbook costs and Booster club membership, are printed on the reverse side of this form. Information regarding the National School Lunch and Breakfast program will be mailed home to each family in late July.

If you live less than 1.5 miles from school, you should have received an application from the Transportation Office to pay for bus transportation for your son or daughter. As a reminder, the application and the \$200 pay rider fee are due to the Transportation Office, 1750 S. Roselle Road, Palatine, IL 60067-7336, no later than July 1, 2017. A \$35 late fee will be charged after July 1, 2017. Please call (847) 755-6798 if you have questions concerning pay transportation.

Reminder to all Freshmen and New Students: You must submit a current physical, appropriate immunization records, proof of residency, and original birth certificate in addition to paying registration fees for the 2017-2018 school year in order for your enrollment to be complete.

In August, tentative schedules and bus information for all students will be available online using the Infinite Campus Parent or Student Portal. As a reminder, all students must pick up an official copy of their schedule on the first day of school; counselor and student locker information will be included on official schedules. Student IDs will be distributed to students on the first day of school.

Freshmen and students new to Hoffman Estates High School will be able to pick up their iPads on the following dates and times: Wednesday, July 26 from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.; Thursday, July 27 from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and from 5:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.; Friday, July 28 from 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m.; and Saturday, July 29 from 10:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. All students must be fully registered, including the payment of school fees prior to picking up their school-issued iPad. Receipt of a school-issued iPad may be delayed if a student is not fully registered by Saturday, July 29.
