

REGISTRATION INFORMATION 2017-2018

Welcome to the 2017-2018 school year. The first day of classes will be **Monday, August 14, 2017**.

Township High School District 211 uses an online registration and fee payment system. You may complete your registration at home or at any location where you have internet access. In late June, you will receive an invoice that will assist you with registration. Online registration will begin on Saturday, July 1, 2017 through Sunday, August 6. You will be able to complete online registration by logging into your ***Infinite Campus Parent Portal***. The link is available on the Schaumburg High School webpage at www.shs.d211.org. Online payments will be accepted through August 6 using a credit or debit card (**MasterCard, Discover, or Visa**). If you do not have access to a computer or if you prefer to pay using cash, check, or money order, walk-in registration will be accepted beginning Mondays through Thursdays, July 24, 25, 26, 27, 31; August 1, 2, 3, 4, 7, 8, and 9 between the hours of 7:30 until 3:00 p.m. Friday, July 28, between 7:30 a.m. until noon. Evening registration will be Thursday, August 3 from 5:00 - 8:00 p.m.

To verify the accuracy of current student information, please review and update the Enrollment Information enclosed. You may submit changes to the form through your Infinite Campus Parent Portal. If returning the form by mail, it must be signed. If any changes in guardianship have occurred, supporting documentation will be required. Documents should be submitted to the Student Services Department. If questions arise, please call (847) 755-4630.

The registration fee for the 2017-2018 school year is \$170 per student. Additional fees, including yearbook costs and Booster club membership, are printed on the reverse side of this form. Information regarding the National School Lunch and Breakfast program will be mailed home to each family in mid July.

If you live less than 1.5 miles from school, you should have received an application from the Transportation Office to pay for bus transportation for your student. As a reminder, the application and the \$200 pay rider fee are due to the Transportation Office, 1750 S. Roselle Road, Palatine, IL 60067-7336, no later than June 30, 2017. A \$35 late fee will be charged after June 30. Please call (847) 755-6798 if you have questions concerning transportation.

Reminder to all Freshmen and New Students: You must submit a current physical, appropriate immunization records, proof of residency, and original birth certificate in addition to paying registration fees for the 2017-2018 school year in order for your enrollment to be complete. If you have questions about the physical or immunizations, please call 847-755-4663.

In early August, tentative schedules and bus information for all students will be available online using the Infinite Campus Parent or Student Portal. All students must pick up an official copy of their schedule on the first day of school, Monday, August 14; counselor and student locker information will be included on all official schedules. Student IDs will be distributed to students during the first week of school.

Schaumburg High School will distribute iPads to students during walk-in registration starting August 1. All students must complete registration, including the payment of school fees, prior to picking up their school-issued iPad. Receipt of an iPad may be delayed for students who complete registration after August 4.
